

Tripp Davis and Associates Courses Recognized in GOLF Magazine's 2020-2021 Course Rankings

Norman, OK (December 2, 2020) — A number of golf courses renovated and restored by golf course architect Tripp Davis and Associates (TDA) were recognized by GOLF Magazine in its new best courses in each state rankings list for 2020-2021.

In Oklahoma, Oak Tree National in Edmond was ranked at #2 and Oklahoma City Golf & Country Club in Nichols Hills came in at #4. In New York, Armonk's Whippoorwill Club was ranked #17 while Oak Hills in San Antonio, Texas was listed at #7.

Maxwell's sensibilities in design are preserved well, particularly on the sweeping dogleg left par four 4th hole. Dedicated students of Maxwell strategy could easily cause a slow play delay examining that green and approach."
